GETTING TO THE SITE

We have a mixture of the following varieties to be planted:

Downy Birch ◆ Hornbeam ◆ Hawthorn ◆ Holly ◆ Crab Apple ◆ Scots Pine Wild Cherry ◆ English Oak ◆ Dog Rose ◆ Goat Willow ◆ Rowan

- There is no heavy digging involved the trees are whips (thin saplings). Instruction on planting will be given by the County Council team.
- Spades will be provided but there might be a wait depending on demand. Please bring your own spade if you can.

- Please wear appropriate footwear. Gloves will be supplied but please bring your own if you can (gardening/heavy duty).
- Please take care around the planting site. Children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times.
