Report

A report was submitted to the Special Council meeting on 11 November 2025, which outlined the potential changes to Committee membership numbers pending the Bebside & Kitty Brewster ward election.

Reform UK won the election with Marcus Nicholson duly being elected on 18 December 2025.

The Committee seats available to the membership of the Council is now.

The change in membership results in Reform UK gaining three seats on Committees and three on sub-Committees. As the seat was previously held by a Conservative member, the Conservative party lose these seats.

Further to this Reform UK also gain one seat on the Partnership Board, with Conservative losing one seat.

Reform UK have indicated a wish to make a further amendment to the Partnership Board, and this is outlined in the table below.

Reform UK have in addition requested to replace J Woods with M Nicholson on the Town Forum.

Standing Orders are also being proposed for amendment, within a separate report, to include the ability to *substitute members of whose role is to replace the ordinary members at a meeting of a committee if the ordinary members of the committee confirm to the Proper Officer 2 days before the meeting that they are unable to attend.*

This is a practice that has been permitted only on Complaints and Grievance Sub Committee previously although was raised by a member several months ago.

The benefit of permitting substitutes on Committees will ensure all Parties have fair opportunity to be represented and ensure Committees are quorate.
